ECVET-Lab is a European initiative funded under the Erasmus+ programme with the aim of creating a Qualification Standard/ Competence Profile on Sustainability among the personnel of Laboratories of Environmental Testing and Science.

These principles have **led ECVET-Lab** partners through the design process of creating an OER Training Course which non-formal, work-based learning outcomes shall be recognised and validated by the ECVET System.

ECVET-Lab project will be made of several activities, linked together to form a log frame matrix being apparently participative. ECVET-Lab project targets Technicians of Environmental Testing Laboratories, laboratories (especially SMEs) and related stakeholders (public institutions and authorities, VET providers, Research institutes, among others). It will involve directly the targets during different activities, especially the collection of good sustainable practices, which will be disseminated Europe wide to foster the exchange and application of better behaviours on the workplace.



GOALS OF THE PROJECT

We have already obtained a qualitative sample of 40 laboratories that are relevant for their experience in the field. However, all European Environmental Testing laboratories are still invited to contribute to the ECVET-Lab Project.



Throughout the month of April we are compiling all the Good Practices implemented by our laboratory sample.



ECVET-Lab focus groups meetings will take place in Valencia (Spain), Nicosia (Cyprus) and Radom (Poland) in May 2017 to discuss applied on environmental best practices.
